- Strong computer skills with Office 365 experience
- Experience, and displayed professionalism, in approaching, building, and maintaining relationships with service delivery partners
- Experience working effectively in a collaborative model within teams and communities
- Proven competency in gardening, including ability to safely operate and maintain tools and equipment
- Adherence to safety protocols around tools and equipment
- Ability to work in a physically demanding job, including lifting and carrying boxes of up to 50 pounds
- Demonstrated knowledge and commitment to the local community and organizational development
- Food Safe Certification (training will be provided if the incumbent is not certified)
- Class 5 driver's licence and provide their own reliable transportation
- A clear criminal record check for working with vulnerable adults and children
